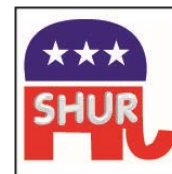

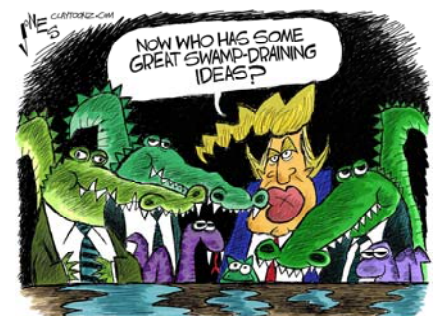
Rewards of Door Knocking
