**It is time to stand up and take back our government!**

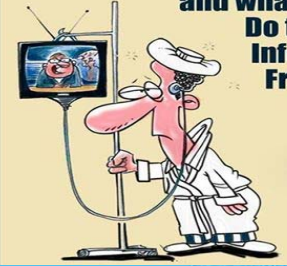
### Why April 17 Is the Tax Deadline

The tax deadline is always postponed when April 15 falls on a weekend or legal holiday.

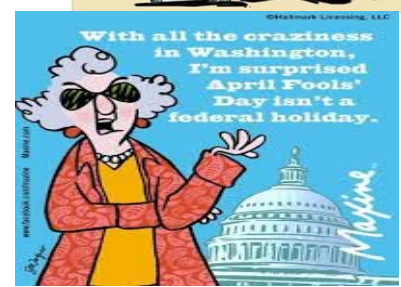
**MON., APRIL 16**

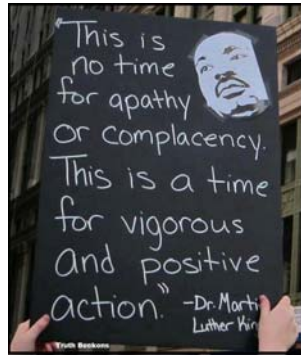
